During its 60 year existence Chestermere High School has developed a tradition of excellence in its academic, athletic and fine arts/ CTS programs. We believe in the values of these in an educational environment and that they are an integral part of school life and the development of the whole student.

Following graduation most students go on to distinguish themselves in college, university and various fields of endeavor. We hope the experiences, memories and friendships formed at Chestermere High School endure for students to cherish and treasure.

Purpose

The Hall of Fame program recognizes the rich heritage of excellence at Chestermere High School and the outstanding contributions of men and women who represent the school with honour, excellence and pride for themselves and their families.

Objectives

The Hall of Fame program objectives are:

- 1. to recognize the tradition of excellence in school programs.**
- 2. to promote, showcase and recognize individual and group success.**
- 3. to make parents, students, teachers and visitors aware of the tradition of excellence within Chestermere High School.**
- 4. to develop pride in the success of these programs.**
- 5. to inspire young people to reach for the excellence of these role models with a goal of someday joining the Hall of Fame.**

HALL OF FAME CRITERIA

ACADEMIC

The Nominee should have three out of six of the following achievements:

- 1) The highest average at one grade level
- 2) Valedictorian
- 3) Earned academic scholarships
- 4) Successful Post-Secondary education
- 5) Must have been on honor roll for two years
- 6) Other significant academic achievements

The nominee must have attended Chestermere High School for a minimum of two years.

ATHLETICS

Eligibility

Athletes and builders are eligible for induction into the HALL OF FAME. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

a) Athletes

To be eligible to enter the HALL OF FAME an athlete must have graduated from Chestermere or spent two years at Chestermere High School and meet one or more of the following criteria:

- 1) The student will represent the sport and school with distinction and excellence in athletic competition at the league, zone, provincial, national or international level.
- 2) The student will have had a successful college or university athletic career.
- 3) The student will have made a provincial team or been recognized as a provincial all-star or participated in a provincial all-star game.
- 4) The student will have achieved provincial, national or international excellence in a non-school sport.
- 5) The student will have participated on an athletic team at the professional level.
- 6) Any other athletic achievement will be considered when voting on nominees.

* To be eligible for induction into the HALL OF FAME the athlete should have completed their athletic career at the college, university or professional level. Normally, an alumnus is not eligible for induction until 5 years after their high school graduation.

b) Builder

A coach, administrator, manager, or other major contributor to the CHS athletic program, will be considered for entry into the HALL OF FAME. Their contribution to the program will be of an outstanding nature and they will have served sport for at least five years. To be eligible as a builder the person must have made a commitment to excellence at Chestermere High School.

FINE ARTS and CAREER TECHNOLOGY STUDIES

Individuals and builders are eligible for induction into the HALL OF FAME. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

a) *Individuals*

To be eligible to enter the HALL OF FAME a nominee must have graduated from Chestermere or spent two years at Chestermere High School and meet one of the following criteria:

- 1) The student will have participated successfully in their area of expertise at the college/university level.
- 2) The student will have participated in specific extension programs during their high school career and made significant contributions to his/her department.
- 3) The student will have participated in their area of expertise, or received recognition, at the provincial, national or international level,
- 4) The student will have participated, in their area, at the professional level.

b) *Builder*

A director, teacher, administrator, or other major contributor to the Chestermere High School Fine Arts/ CTS program will be considered for entry into the HALL OF FAME. Their contribution to the program will be of an outstanding nature and they will have served Fine Arts/ CTS for at least five years. To be eligible as a builder the person must have made a commitment to excellence in the arts at Chestermere.

DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI

To be eligible to enter the Hall of Fame a nominee must have distinguished themselves in one or more of the following ways:

- 1) Dynamic volunteer spirit and contribution.
- 2) Recognition within or by the community.
- 3) Special awards.
- 4) Special achievements within their field.
